What is a TEFIP?

When completed, the Clatsop County Tsunami Evacuation Facility Improvement Plan (TEFIP) will be a plan for improving tsunami evacuation routes and trails in Clatsop County. This TEFIP will focus on routes that serve multiple purposes in addition to evacuation, such as walking or cycling trails.

What is happening now?

- With the help of community input, the project team has identified areas that need evacuation routes and has located nearby trails.
- You are invited to review proposed evacuation trail connections and other facilities, and provide your suggestions.
- Share your thoughts on potential trail amenities to make trails more useful, like benches, lighting, and bicycle parking.
