The Clatsop County Board of Commissioners fully supports HB 2948-2 and the appropriation of \$20 million for grants for improvement of fairgrounds used for emergency evacuation sites.

Although, the Clatsop County Fairgrounds has been designated as an evacuation site, it has a number of critical infrastructures needs that could be addressed via this funding source. Clatsop County is in a high-risk area with particular vulnerability to earthquake, tsunami, coastal storms and wildfires.
