What is Household Hazardous Waste?

Many hazardous products used in and around the home accumulate in our cabinets, garage shelves, or outdoor sheds. Having these hazardous chemicals in the home can present health hazards, especially for children and pets. Many household consumer products contain flammable, toxic, or corrosive chemicals that make them hazardous.

When people improperly dispose of household hazardous waste, it can contaminate drinking water supplies and public waters, damage wastewater treatment systems and onsite septic systems. It also can expose sanitation workers and firefighters to hazardous situations, and negatively impact the environment.



Household hazardous waste requires special handling and safe disposal for everyone's protection.

 - Light ballasts
 - Batteries
- Items containing mercury
- Cleaners and disinfectants

Safe Handling & Transport

- Keep products in their original container if possible.
- Label product if not in original container (label as unknown if unknown).
- Do not mix products together.
- Make sure products are properly sealed to prevent leaks and spills.
- If container is leaking, secure it in a secondary leak-proof container.
- **Secure** HHW items in rear of your vehicle to ease removal.
- Containers must be less than 5 gallons each.

Small Business Participation

Conditionally Exempt Generators (CEGs/CESQG) are businesses that do not generate more than 220 pounds of hazardous waste each month.

Hazardous waste from CEGs cannot be dropped off at HHW events, these events are for household hazardous waste only. Contact Clatsop County Environmental Health in advance to schedule an appointment to drop off commercial hazardous waste.
